Discovering Ireland

Ireland is a land steeped deep in myth, history and tradition. There are many monuments that are old beyond belief. Take Newgrange, Knowth, Dowth and Loughcrew as perfect examples; they are older than the pyramids in Egypt and Stonehenge in England.

The Irish countryside, towns and cities are dotted with castles built at various points in history. Some of these are now crumbling, while others have been restored to their former glory, others still have been immortalised in movies. Trim castle in County Meath was used extensively in Mel Gibson's 1995 movie, Braveheart (which was mostly shot on location in Ireland). Other famous movies filmed in whole or in part in Ireland include: Ondine, Saving Private Ryan, Harry Potter & The Half Blood Prince, King Arthur, The Italian Job, P.S. I Love You, Moby Dick and The Princess Bride.

Over the millennia Ireland has had many visitors, some have been friendly and some have not. The Vikings started to 'visit' these shores from the end of the 7th century. Initially they were invaders who would arrive in their longboats or drakkars to pillage and steal. From the late 8th and early 9th centuries on, Vikings started to settle peacefully here; marry Irish people and even adopted the native language (Gaelic). Many Irish towns were originally founded by the Vikings; including Dublin, Waterford and Limerick.

The English are famous for their empire and as their nearest neighbour, it is not surprising to learn that Ireland has had many problems due to British colonialism over the years. Over the years there have been countless rebellions. The final push was the war of independence, culminating in 1921 with British soldiers leaving the southern part of Ireland, the patrician of Ireland and the formation of the Irish Free State, now The Republic of Ireland.







The fact that Northern Ireland was created in 1921 has lead to its own problems over the years. Ireland experienced one of our darkest episodes between the years 1921-1923 – the Irish Civil War. Organisations like the I.R.A. (Irish Republican Army) continued fighting over the years. Their aim was to get British soldiers out of Northern Ireland and the reunification of Ireland. It is only in recent years that this situation has improved, with the Good Friday Agreement coming into force in 1999.

All through history, in good times and bad, the Irish spirit has remained untouched. Irish literature, music and art is known and respected the world over. Great Irish writers like James Joyce, Samuel Beckett, Bram Stoker, George Bernard Shaw, Oscar Wilde, Brian Friel and Roddy Doyle are known all over the world and have had their work translated into hundreds of languages. Irish actors and actresses have been involved in some of the world's biggest and best movies and TV shows, people like; Liam Neeson, Gabriel Byrne, Colin Farrel, Brendan Gleeson, Pierce Brosnan, Colm Meaney, Michael Fassbender, Richard Harris and Saoirse Ronan are some of the best actors in the world today... and they are all Irish!

Our courses give you a practical understanding of the language and teach you how to use it as best as you can.


Course Aims at NED Training Centre:

In NED Training Centre, we also offer other course options:






Other Facilities






Accommodation

Our aim is to make you feel at home in Ireland. Your accommodation is an extremely important part of your whole experience. The different locations where we accommodate students are all close to public transport, shopping centres, supermarkets and banks. With NED Training Centre you can rest assured that we will provide you with quality accommodation that best suits your needs. NED Training Centre offers two different accommodation options to our students: host family or hostel.

Host Family

The school maintains a database of host families that we recruit through local advertising and online advertising. All our host families are carefully selected and subject to the school's QA requirements. Initially, the school interviews

the families and gains knowledge about them through our host family questionnaire. Once the school is satisfied that the family is suitable, we place them on our host family database. Host families are regularly inspected and all students are required to give feedback on host families. Any negative feedback is noted and a random inspection will be carried out to ascertain the severity of the complaint. Any families with serious complaints are removed from our database.

Hostel

Our hostel is located near the school. The accommodation provides shared or private rooms, Wi-Fi and a common area.

Airport Transfer

Health Insurance

All non EU/EEA students require health insurance to get a study visa. NED Training Centre can organise all the steps to guarantee our students a Health Insurance before their arrival. The Health Insurance protects you against any illness or injury which may happen during your time in Ireland.

If you are a European Student, you should bring an European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) from your own country in order to avail of the same services as Irish people under the public health scheme.

Europeans also may opt to purchase private health insurance before traveling to Ireland.
