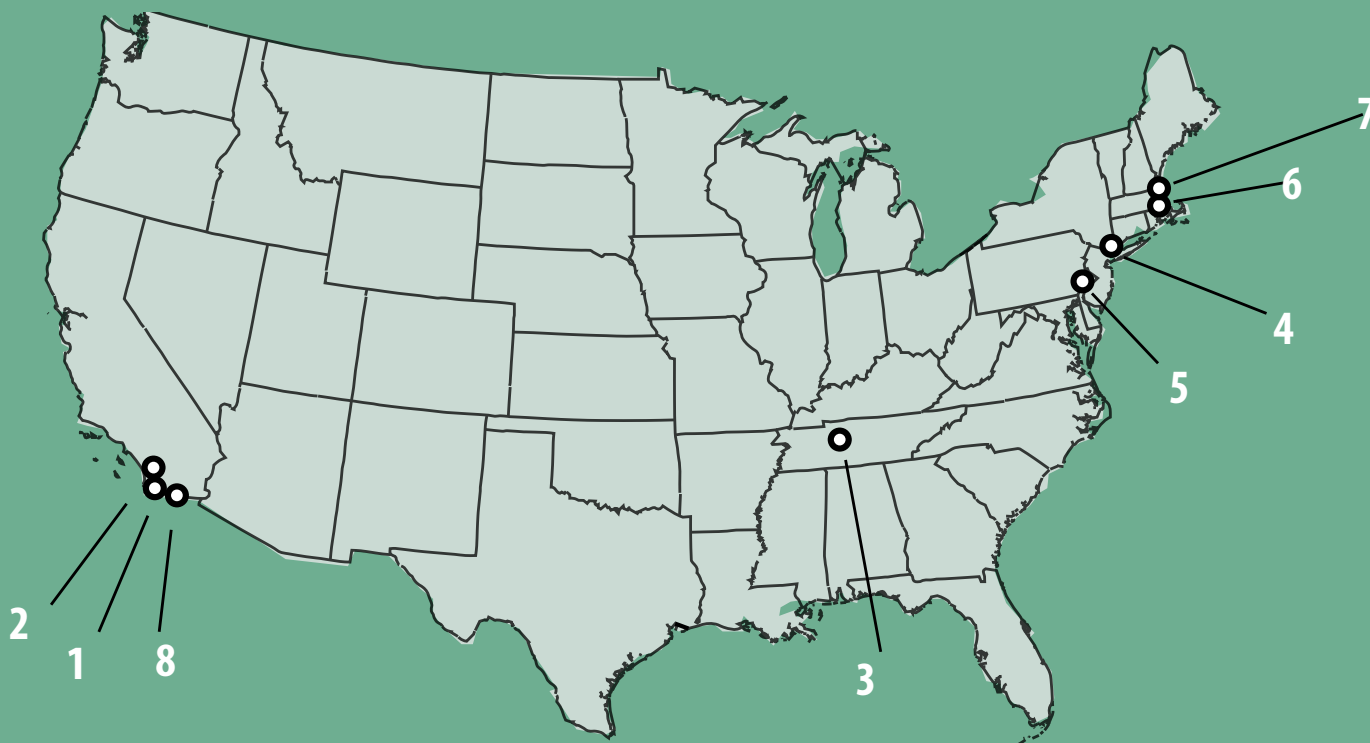
Students should arrive between 2:00-9:00 PM. For students that use our transfer service, FLS will communicate and arrange the arrival and check-in with the host family.
