



How we teach...

The curriculum is designed to develop a student's overall level of English, focusing on all of the key skills of reading, writing, speaking, listening, grammar and vocabulary.

The teachers work alongside the course objectives and use methodologies such as Task Based Learning (TBL), Communicative Language Teaching (CLT), and Co-operative Language Learning (CLL).




