WHAT IS AN INTEGRATION COURSE?

Are you permanently living in Germany, do you have a registered fixed residence here, do you wish to work here and plan your centre of life in Hamburg?
The **Bundesamt für Migration und Flüchtlinge (BamF)** sponsors your Integration course as an important component of a successful integration. Integration courses have 15-25 students per class and under certain circumstances they can be subsidized by the 'BamF' with a percentage of 50% (for example). Please ask for further information.

CONTENT

If you want to live in Germany, you should learn German! This is important when you are looking for work, have to fill in applications, wish to support your children in school or when you would like to meet new people. Also, you should know some things about Germany, for example, about the history, the culture and the legal system.

TEACHING HOURS

The integration courses take place every day (Mon-Fri) from 8.50-13.00 or from 13.30-17.45. Please ask for the starting dates for beginners personally. Participants with previous knowledge in German get the possible start date assigned after their personal placement test.

COSTS

Integration courses are divided into 6 modules plus the orientation course 'Living in Germany'. Each module contains 100 lessons, the participants' contribution is € 195.-* per module. The orientation course consists of 100 teaching hours and also costs € 195.-*.

You may be exempt from the fee if you are registered as unemployed (SGBII), a Hartz IV-recipient or get financial help for livelihood (SGB XII). Another possibility to be exempt from the fee is if you receive housing benefit or do not have to pay for the GEZ. Please present written documentation of your exempted status when you register!

PLACEMENT AND REGISTRATION

To book a course, we need your legal authorization to attend an integration course or the 'Verpflichtungserklärung' to attend an integration course.

Each participant is required to take a placement test. The written placement can be taken at any time, please ask for an appointment for the oral placement. Thank you!

EU citizens with a permanent residence in Hamburg can apply for admission to an integration course at Colón by showing your ID card.

EXAMINATION AND CERTIFICATE

The course ends with the TELC DTZ exam (A2-B1) and the orientation course test.

TEACHING BOOKS

We use modern teaching materials. Each module has its own course book: Schritte plus Neu 1-6 (per book approx. 16.- €*). The orientation course has also its own book: Zur Orientierung (approx. 14.- €*). Teaching material is not included in the course price.

All books can be bought at the Colón Bookshop in our school.

GERMAN EXAMS & PREPARATION

CERTIFICATES

Each level ends with a final Colón test (included in the course price). On request we can issue a Colón certificate for your level. Colón Certificates may be presented as proof of German language skills for the preparatory course (Studienkolleg) at German universities (level B2).

Colón is an official TELC testing centre and offers the following internationally recognized TELC-exams: A1-C1. TELC Language Certificates document your language skills in listening, reading, speaking and writing: for training, study and work.

TELCE-Exam „Start Deutsch A1“: Do you need proof of "basic German language skills" because you want to apply for a visa with the purpose of immigration of spouses (Ehegattennachzug)? The German embassies recognize the certificate TELC German A1.

TELCE-Exam „Start Deutsch A2“: You can interact in a simple way in everyday situations, hold short conversations and use simple sentence structures correctly.

TELCE-Exam „Zertifikat Deutsch B1“: For naturalization in Germany, the German B1 certificate is recognized as proof of sufficient language skills.

TELCE-Exam „Zertifikat Deutsch Plus B2“: You can express yourself in detail, argue and negotiate successfully. In your own field and in the most common topics you have a large vocabulary. You master the grammar quite well.

TELCE-Exam „Deutsch C1“: You can express yourself fluently and spontaneously. You are familiar with colloquialisms and can vary the style of language specifically. You maintain a high degree of grammatical accuracy. **Tele C1 Hochschule** is recognized as language certificate for foreign students to enter German universities.

THE DAY OF YOUR EXAM

The TELC exams consist of a written test in the morning (9.00 - 13.00) and an oral exam in the afternoon (from 13.30 on).

REQUIREMENTS / REGISTRATION

The requirement for a successful test is the state of knowledge in German to the current level. Colón students receive feedback from their teacher in class. A placement test can also be made in advance.

The exam format will be presented with TELC model tests and the various parts of the exam will be worked through in detail. The results are discussed with all participants and is the individual basis for independent further learning and the detailed and successful preparation for the exam. Experience has shown that the written part of the B1 and B2 examination is the most difficult. Here students get valuable tips and help. The preparation course takes about 3 weeks before the exam so that sufficient time remains for further studying.

A Colón host can be a family or a single person. Some hosts are married, others not. They have many different professions and are of all ages and social strata.

Our hosts offer you a special opportunity to practise your German after school and at the week-ends. We work with over 50 households in Hamburg, all have been inspected by Colón, and many have been hosting our students for many years.
