

You usually have a different tutor for mornings and afternoons so you will be able to hear different accents.


NZ Certificate in English Language (NZCEL)

Pathways to further study


The following diagram shows various pathways from English language to further academic studies available at Ara. You can start at any point according to your level and our staff will assist you along the way.




