

EXAM PREPARATION





IELTS - [INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH LANGUAGE TESTING SYSTEM]

- Full time exam preparation program in Canadian GV schools (25 or 30 lessons per week)
- GV Hawaii offers an IELTS Options program.
- Focuses on the main components of Academic English as used in university-style courses
- Test practice components build familiarity with the format of the test and provide students with the opportunity to practice a range of test-taking strategies
- Best choice for students seeking international education, professional recognition, benchmarking to international standards, and global mobility
- Official IELTS exam held multiple times per month in each GV school (monthly in Hawaii)

TOEFL - [TEST OF ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- Full time exam preparation program available at GV Vancouver (25 lessons per week).
- Full or part time preparation program available at GV Hawaii (20 or 25 lessons per week)
- Focuses on improving all four language skills (reading, writing, listening, and speaking)
- Strong choice for students preparing for university entrance

CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH

- Entrance Exam Required
- FCE, CAE and CPE preparation and examination available up to 4 times per year, depending on location
- Focuses on 5 main skills covered in the exam: reading, writing, use of English (grammar), listening, and speaking
- Weekly practice tests
- Full mock exam at end of session
- Official examinations are held in the week after the program is completed on dates set by the University of Cambridge
- Exam results and certificates provided by the University of Cambridge

TOEIC - [TEST OF ENGLISH FOR INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATION]

- Full time or part time program at GV Hawaii (20 or 25 lessons per week)
- Afternoon elective class at GV Calgary
- Students learn the strategies needed to write the TOEIC exam
- Focus on main components of the TOEIC exam: listening comprehension, reading, business-oriented vocabulary review, and grammar review.
