

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

Students must be 18 years of age or older to apply.

ESL PROGRAM

- 12-week quarters with 4 hours of instruction per day, Monday through Friday
- Textbooks and workbooks included in tuition
- Daily journal writing with corrections
- Book club classes comprehension questions, vocabulary, and discussion (books available on campus for students to check out)
- Culture Week each guarter that includes concerts, museum tours, live theater performances, etc.
- Optional weekend outings and field trips with instructors, such as visits to points interest, tours of famous corporations, hiking and beach trips, etc.)

It is imperative that our young generations have the creativity necessary to envision a better future and the skills required to carry out those grand visions to become

carry out those grand visions to become Global Leaders. Through this program, we wish to cultivate students who can function effectively and efficiently in diverse cultural contexts by encouraging cultural exchange, developing leadership skills, and increasing English proficiency.

Each week will include reading, writing,



listening, and speaking and will build on grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation.

Weekly themes of getting to know each other, shopping, food, and government will help students familiarize themselves with American culture while learning English. Students will be tested on Fridays to assess what they've learned that week. Wednesday afternoons and Saturdays will be used for cultural exposure through group activities or field trips (such as tours, theme park visits, live performances, etc.). Students will also be reading pre-chosen books in the evening hours and completing vocabulary and comprehension questions. They will also be writing daily journal entries that will be checked by the instructor in class to help them improve their writing skills.
