The Haggerty English Language Program (HELP) is located at the State University of New York (SUNY) at New Paltz.


WHAT AND WHERE IS SUNY NEW PALTZ?

- Admission to ESL, Undergraduate, and Graduate Programs possible

- Proficiency tests are given on campus
- Institutional TOEFL given each session
- Placement in one of four different levels of English language study




WHAT ARE WE PROUD OF?


