ESL PROGRAM

01

Intensive Conversation

Our Intensive Conversation class helps students to develop the listening and speaking skills they will need both for academic purposes and for day-to-day conversation. It also emphasizes accent reduction.

02

Reading/ Vocabulary

Our reading class emphasizes building English vocabulary. The class helps students to develop reading skills in English for academic and general usages.

03

Grammar

Our grammar class helps students to better understand and use grammatical structures in English. The class also focuses on both oral and written usage of English grammar.

04

Public Speaking

This course is an introduction to speech communication which emphasizes the practical skill of public speaking, including techniques to lessen speaker anxiety, and the use of visual aids to enhance speaker presentations.

05

Academic Writing

Our writing class helps students to focus on the skills needed to perform well in writing English both in academic writing and writhing for personal purposes.

06

English Literature

This American Literature course will focus on reading and analyzing significant works of American literature.

iBT TOEFL Preparation

Our Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) preparation course focuses on preparing students to successfully improve the English language skills assessed by the TOEFL. Those skills include Reading, Listening, Speaking, and Writing. Our instructors are also trained to provide students with TOEFL examination techniques and test-taking strategies to help them to quickly and effectively improve their test scores. Students will practice extensively by taking actual TOEFL tests and answering real TOEFL questions. Students are prepared to take the TOEFL Internet Based Test (iBT) but all other versions (i.e. TOEFL CBT and TOEFL PBT) also are covered in the classroom. Students are also encouraged to take additional practice tests outside of classroom.

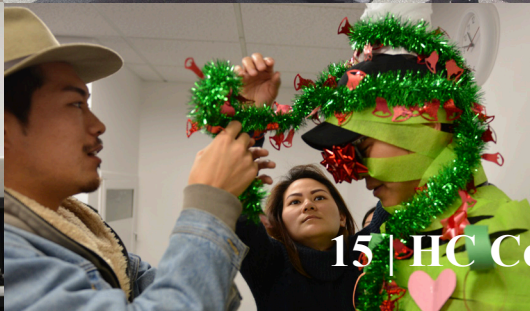
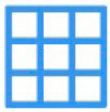
