STRUCTURE OF THE ENTRANCE EXAM

General exam, required

- Lengua castellana y literatura
- Lengua extranjera
- Historia de España

Specialized exam

CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Matemáticas
- Matemáticas aplicadas a las ciencias sociales
- Fundamentos de las artes
- Latín

Additional subjects

To improve your grade on the entrance exam (and boost your chances of being admitted to a university), this option allows you to choose two subjects related to the studies you want to pursue:

- **Ciencias, ciencias de la salud y tecnología:**
Biología, química, matemáticas, física.
- **Humanidades y sociales:**
Economía de la empresa, fundamentos de las artes, geografía, matemáticas aplicadas a las ciencias sociales.

Frequently asked questions

FAQ



What's a typical day of class like?

You can choose to take classes in the morning (9 a.m. to 2 p.m.) or afternoon (3 p.m. to 9 p.m.)

You'll have classes for all the subjects you choose during this time.

How many students are in each class?

That depends on the subject. For the required subjects (Spanish, English, and History of Spain) there are 25 to 30 students per class.

For the other subjects, classes have 5 to 20 students.

What countries are the students from?

We have students of every nationality, but the majority are from South America, the Maghreb, or northern Eurasia (Russia, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, etc.). We also have many students from

Asia (South Korea, China, Nepal, etc.).

How many classes are there each week?

25 classes per week.

What are the start dates?

The course runs from October to May or January to May. The exam is in June.

What is the university admissions process like?

It's very similar to the process that Spanish students go through. During the month of June, you must complete the university pre-enrollment process, keeping in mind that the areas of studies you will be eligible to pursue in university will depend on the grade you get on the PAU/PCE university entrance exam.

Once you get your results and see which universities you've been accepted to, you will choose which university you want to attend, pay the enrollment fee (by the end of July), and start studying at the university in September.

At Enforex we advise and help students every step of the way during this long process.

How do I choose which subjects to take at Enforex?

We offer a wide variety of options tailored to the needs of each student. You can decide to take anywhere from just one subject to the full course load. The price will depend on the option you choose.

What documents do I need?

You must bring your diploma equivalent to the Spanish Baccalaureate and your grades from the last two years. You will need a Hague Apostille for these documents from your home country.

Our documentation manager can advise you on the documents you need depending on the country where you earned your diploma.

From there, we will begin the translation and homologation process.

Your diploma equivalent to the Spanish Baccalaureate must be validated through the homologation process before you can be admitted.
